### **April 4, 2020 minutes**

The April 4, 2020 minutes were moved and seconded for approval by Co-Chair Emeritus Jose Arandia and Member Michael Hansen, and then approved by the members.

### **Chapel Bell Ringing**

Chair Logan Gluck and Chair Emeritus Dennis D'Andrea recognized the continuing weekly efforts for the Friday 7pm Wainscott Chapel bell-ringing led by Member Bruce Solomon and the Wainscott Sewing Society's collaboration on the thank you banner in front of the Chapel.

### **Liaison Report: Councilman Jeff Bragman**

#### Beaches

Councilman Bragman began by noting that the town is considering whether and how to open the beaches, as well as trails and parks.

#### Food Pantries

Councilman Bragman next reported that the Town had considered making a financial allocation to local food pantries such as Meals on Wheels and East End cares, but the proposal was not adopted as the sense was that donations had increased.

#### Reopening Businesses

Councilman Bragman noted that the Town is not enthusiastic about opening up businesses given their understanding of recent governmental reporting.

#### Local Command System

Councilman Bragman discussed the Town command system running through the Town Supervisor during the pandemic.

#### Airport

Councilman Bragman reported that the Town is working toward a meeting with the FAA, although nothing can be reported on this matter at this time.

#### Rentals

Councilman Bragman noted that there was some discussion at the Town Board about whether to ban short-term rentals.

#### Farmers Market

Councilman Bragman noted that the Town is considering whether to open the farmers market.

#### Restaurants

Councilman Bragman indicated that it is premature to permit outdoor and other restaurant dining.

Discussion then ensued about opening businesses, rental and construction issues including what to do if contractors are working illegally at a home site.

### **Remembrances of Rick Del Mastro**

Chair Logan Gluck then encouraged people to share their memories of Chair Emeritus Rick Del Mastro. The Members and others at the meeting discussed their respect and fondness for Rick and his importance to the community. The meeting also discussed various possible memorial actions to honor Rick's memory and determined to continue considering an appropriate recognition.

The meeting then was adjourned at 11:29am.
